

**CANCELLATION OF
EXECUTIVE ORDER NOS. 2020-01, 2020-05, and 2020-09
COVID-19**

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the City Manager of the City of Venice enacted Executive Order No. 2020-01 which declared a State of Local Emergency due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Extension No. 1 of Executive Order No. 2020-01 dated March 23, 2020, the State of Local Emergency has been automatically extended in 7-day increments to date; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the enactment of Executive Order No. 2020-01, additional Executive Orders were issued by the City Manager of the City of Venice in order to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the community during the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 2020-05, pertaining to mobile food dispensing vehicles, and Executive Order No. 2020-09, pertaining to outside dining and temporary signs, remain in effect; and

WHEREAS, the state of emergency for the entire State of Florida declared by Governor DeSantis in Executive Order 20-52, as subsequently extended, is set to expire on June 26, 2021; and

WHEREAS, conditions constituting a State of Local Emergency for COVID-19 no longer exist within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edward Lavallee, City Manager of the City of Venice, hereby order that Executive Order Nos. 2020-01, 2020-05, and 2020-09 are cancelled effective as of 11:59 p.m. on June 26, 2021.
